Fifth Annual "Stop Spam Today!" Campaign Gives Nonprofits and Libraries Free Software to Battle Spam

Register now for giveaway on December 5, 2007

San Francisco, CA –November 15, 2007 – TechSoup (www.techsoup.org) and Mailshell, Inc. (<http://www.mailshell.com>) today announced the fifth annual “Stop Spam Today!” campaign (www.stopspamtoday.org), a month-long nationwide effort to help nonprofits and public libraries fight spam by providing free information, resources and tools. The campaign culminates on December 5th in a one-day giveaway where nonprofits and libraries can get free copies of Mailshell’s Anti-Spam Desktop software. The December 5th giveaway comes at the end of a push to educate nonprofits via articles, discussions and tools featured on the TechSoup site.
